

PHYSICAL THERAPY PLUS **PAYMENT POLICY/INSURANCE**

PT Plus accepts most private, Workers' Compensation and No Fault insurances. A list of providers with whom we currently work is available in our office and on our website, but please contact us if your insurance provider does not appear on the list.

Please bring your insurance card on your first visit. Our administrative staff will verify your insurance benefits prior to your first visit so you will know what to expect. For your convenience we accept MasterCard, VISA, Discover, American Express and personal checks for co-pays.

We also have self payment options with affordable, customized plans for those who need it. Please contact our Billing Department (315)476-3176 if you wish to work out a customized patient plan or have any other questions.

PATIENT RESPONSIBILITY

If your insurance coverage includes co-payments, co-insurance or deductibles, it will be your responsibility to pay them at the time of service. Our billing staff will be happy to help you understand your benefits and financial responsibilities - and help you in any way that we can. If the information you give us is incorrect or inaccurate, you may be held responsible for payment of services rendered; therefore, it is very important to let us know immediately if your insurance changes.

PRIVATE and NO FAULT INSURANCE

Please make sure you give us appropriate provider information so we can process your claim quickly and accurately. We work with a wide variety of private and No Fault carriers to make things as convenient as possible for our patients. For your convenience, we also accept MasterCard, Visa, American Express and personal checks for payments.

MEDICARE INSURANCE

Medicare patients are required (by Federal regulation) to see their Primary Care physician or referring provider on a monthly basis. In order to continue receiving physical therapy at PT Plus, a plan of care will be submitted to your physician for his approval.

WORKERS' COMPENSATION

Please check with your employer's Workers' Compensation insurance provider to make sure you have completed the accident report and have filed all the required paperwork necessary to collect Workers' Compensation benefits. It is also important that you let your PT Plus therapist know when you have a follow-up appointment with your referring physician. The Therapist will send your physician a progress note regarding your care at PT Plus.
